

Town of Eastend, Saskatchewan  
Bylaw No. 175

A Bylaw of the Town of Eastend, Saskatchewan regulating the keeping of livestock and the storing of grain within the limits of the Town of Eastend, Saskatchewan.

1. The keeping of livestock or poultry on any of the Blocks numbered from ONE(1) to FORTY-TWO (42) within the limits of the Town of Eastend or on any blocks hereafter surveyed into lots for building purposes is hereby prohibited.
2. The storing of grain in any granary or building which is not completely rat-proof within the limits of the Town of Eastend is likewise prohibited.
3. Any person violating the provisions of this bylaw shall upon conviction be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town of Eastend, Saskatchewan.
4. Read three times by unanimous vote of all members of the Council present and finally passed this 3rd day of September, 1963.
