WELCOME TO THE T. rex DISCOVERY CENTRE NATURE TRAIL!

This trail covers about 2 km of moderate to somewhat difficult terrain, leading to 9 viewing sites. Sturdy shoes are recommended. Be sure to watch for wood ticks, which are mostly an issue in May and June, prickly pear cactus and gopher holes.

Please stay on the trail to avoid disturbing the plants and wildlife, and do not litter.

For a shorter walk, take the path that leads from the Centre to our benches, or over to the Northwest Mounted Police Trailmarker (viewing site #1) and back.
